DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Vale Summit Methodist Church is located on the south side of Route 55 near its junction with the Loartown Road in Vale Summit, Allegany County.

The Vale Summit Methodist Church is a single story, one bay wide rectangular block. The building is of frame construction and has been covered with weatherboard. It rests on a high, replaced block foundation with a plain water table. Two steeply gabled additions abut the main block on the north and south sides. The roof is gabled with a soffit and is covered with asphalt shingles. Four large stained glass windows with cornices are located on the east and west sides of the church. A single "Gothic" sash window with a Keystone is located above the main door. The main entrance is located on the north side of the building in the gable-roofed addition and features a replaced door with a broken pediment and a stained glass transom light. The roofline is topped by an original, corbeled brick, outside end chimney and a small louvered belfry.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Vale Summit Methodist Church was constructed in 1889.¹ The congregation had been organized under the direction of John Fatkin that same year. The construction of the church was undoubtedly undertaken to meet the growing demands of the mining community of Vale Summit. In addition, Methodism was one of the most popular religions among the miners. "Methodism had spread rapidly among English miners during the 19th century and had brought them much in return including free education for their children, improved living and working conditions and training in leadership."²

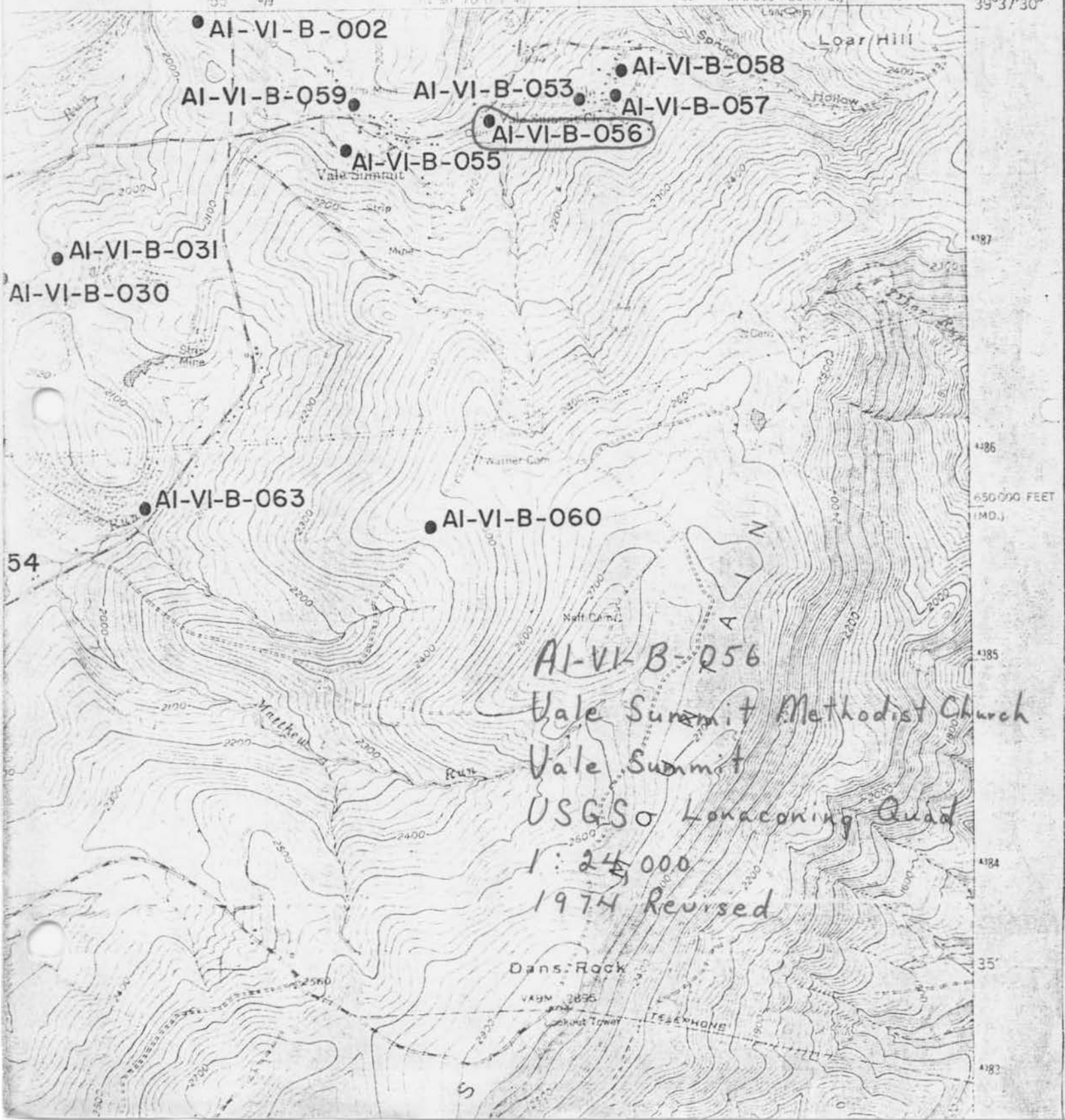
