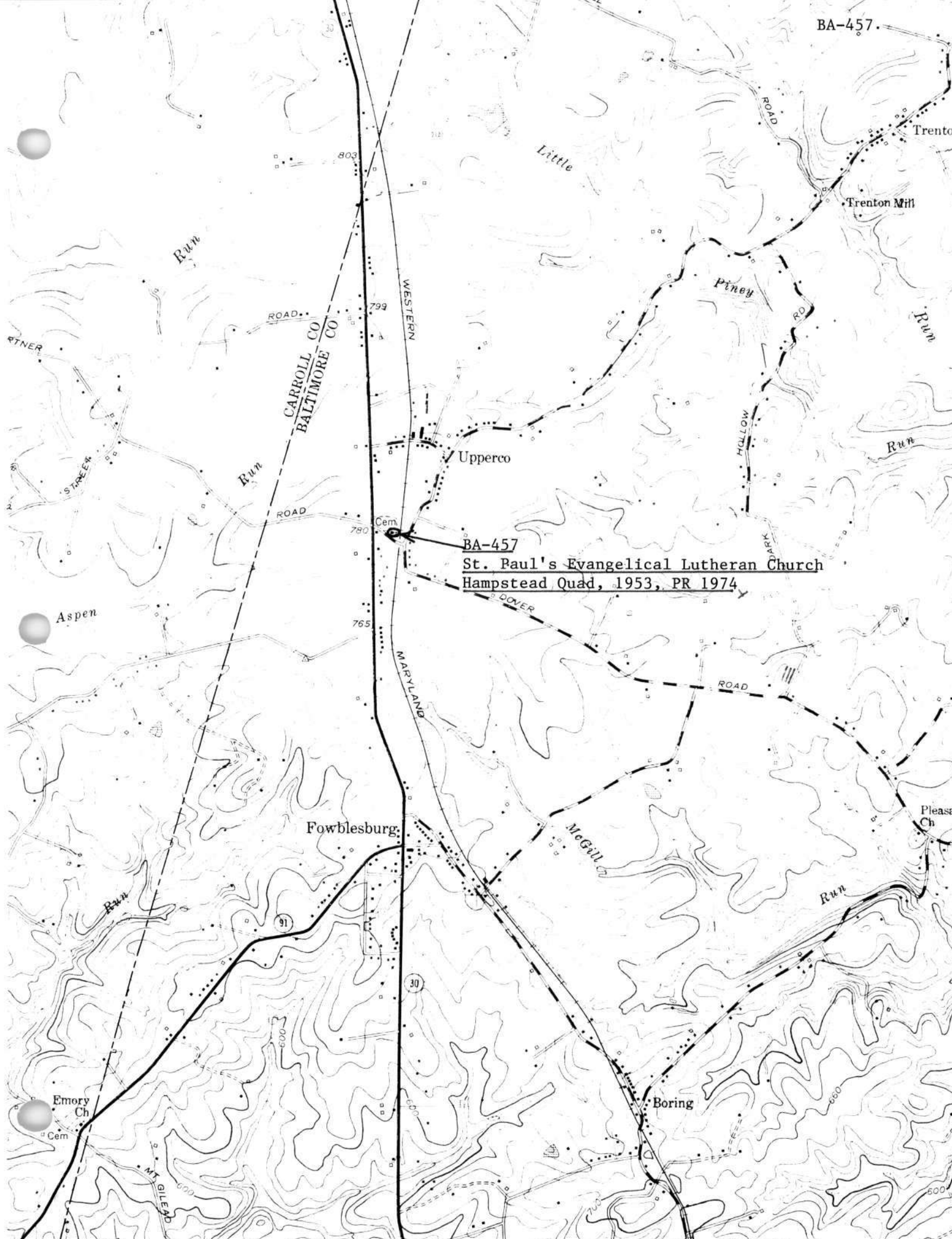

ST. PAUL'S (EVANGELICAL) LUTHERAN CHURCH - 1882 -
(North side of) 15801 Dover Road, just east of Hanover Road, Arcadia. Congregation can be traced back to 1770; a log church was replaced by the present brick structure in 1882; enlarged 1892 and 1963. Generally in Georgian Revival style; gable roof; cupola. Historical marker erected in 1975.

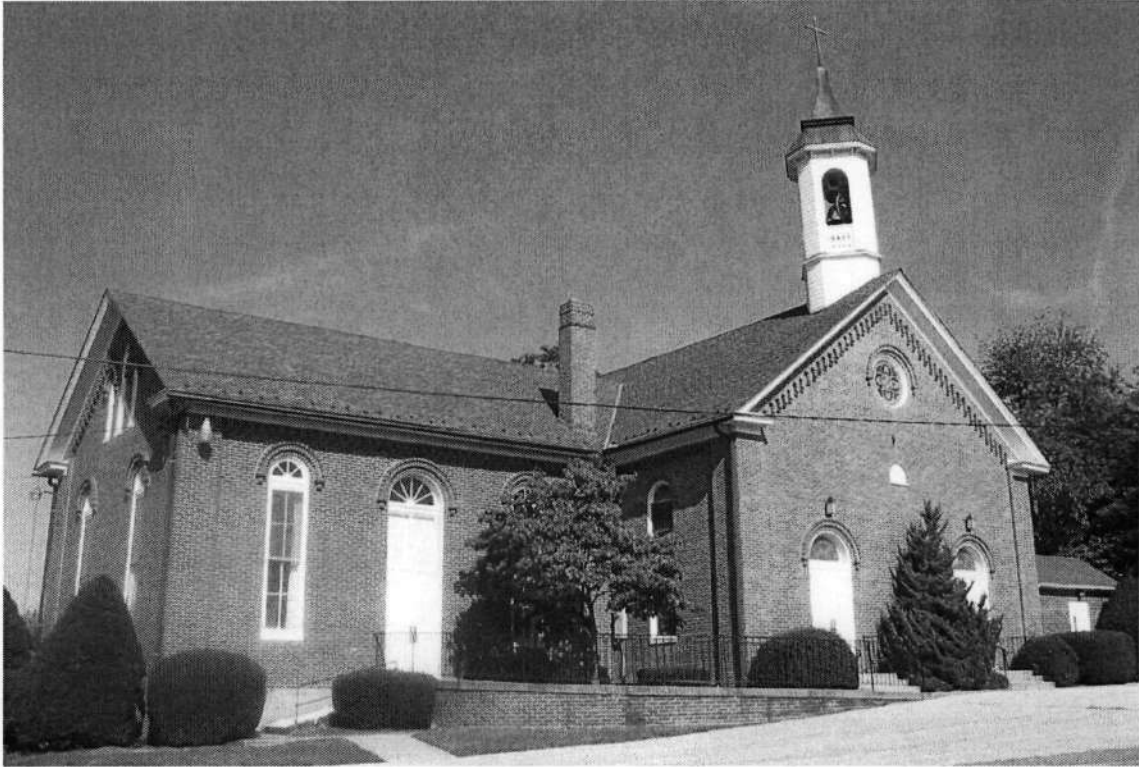
