Located on the north side of Mount Hermon Road, Hammond Cemetery is a relatively large family cemetery. It contains approximately 100 graves dating from 1882 to the 1990s. With the exception of one of the earlier, relatively ornate, grave markers, the stones are simple in design. The cemetery is enclosed on one side by a decorative iron fence and entrance gate with Hammond Cemetery across the top, the other three sides are enclosed by a simple metal fence.

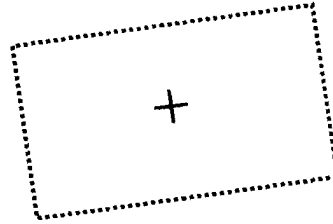

Resource Sketch Map

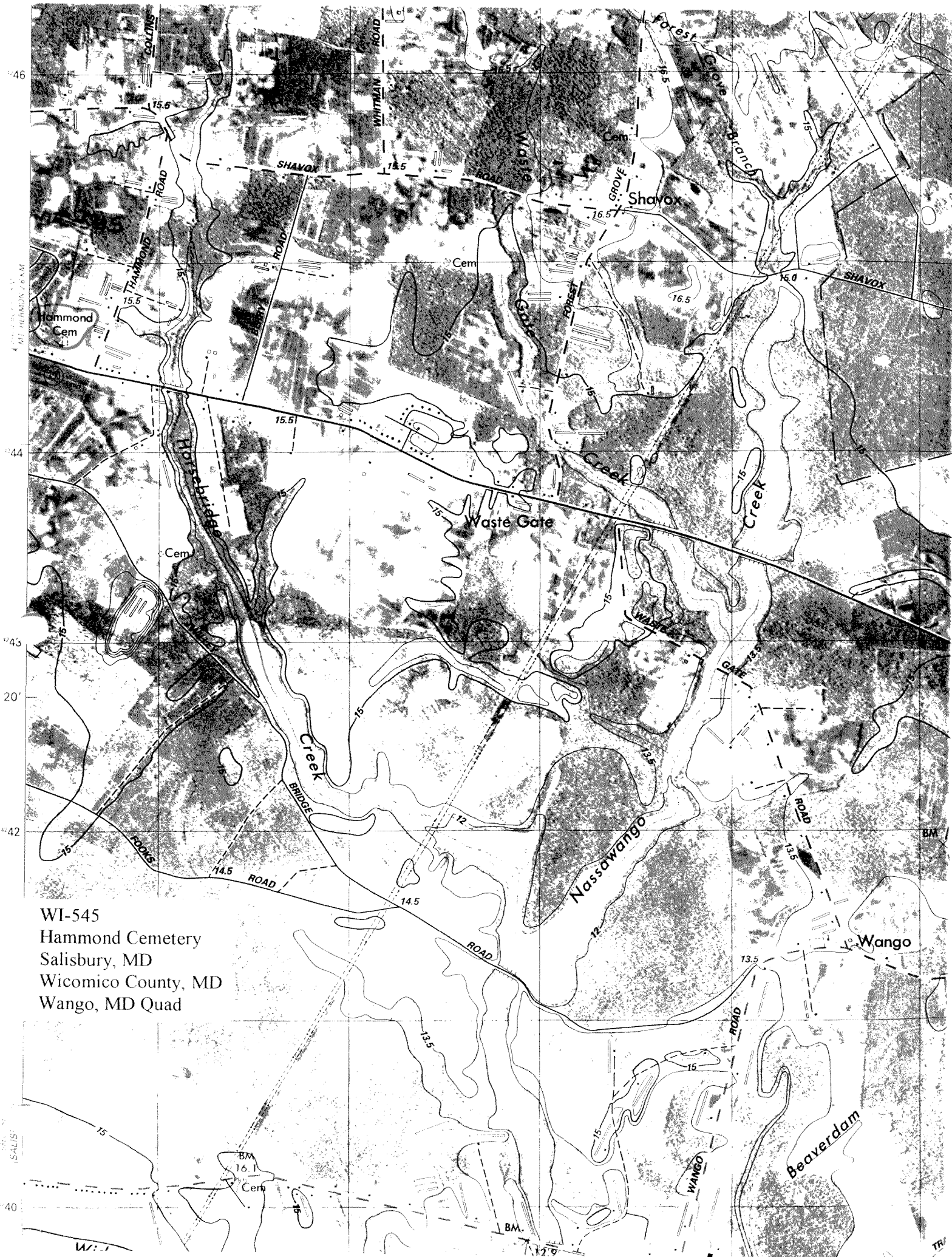
