## Summary Description:

The Ladson Site (18FR652) is an apparent Middle Woodland lithic scatter situated on the eastern bank of the Monocacy River, east of Frederick, Maryland. The site is situated at the base of a slope on an old alluvial terrace of Elk loam soils. The site was discovered during the Phase I portion of the Monocacy Interceptor Sewer Line project in 1990. A total of 780 initial shovel test pits were excavated at 20 meter intervals along the sewer corridor centerline. Shovel test 288 recovered one large Selby Bay lanceolate point, and exposed a burnt earth feature. The possible presence of a cultural feature led to the implementation of Phase II work at 18FR652.

Two 1 X 1 meter units were opened over the feature, revealing that it had been truncated by plowing. The feature represented a burned tree stump; analysis of the associated charcoal indicates that the tree was an ash. The one large Selby Bay lanceolate point from the shovel test was physically associated with the feature; it is unlikely that it was depositionally associated. Two unmodified flakes and one possible core were also recovered from the test units, although not in association with the feature. No other materials were found in nearby shovel tests.

It should be noted that the Ladson Site was located at the base of a slope on an old alluvial terrace. It is possible that a prehistoric site exists upslope from where the artifacts were found; it is also possible that the artifacts are the remnants of a site that has been destroyed by the river. However, no such site has been recorded.
