Summary Description:

The Campbell Ditch Site (18WC100) is a prehistoric burial site with remains of 2 or more individuals, possibly dating to the Woodland period. It is located on an interior flat about 90 m from the Campbell Ditch, a freshwater stream in Wicomico County. The bones were uncovered during land clearance for development in the vicinity of the root ball of a bulldozed tree. Just how much of the site had been destroyed is unclear.

Methods of investigation included shovel-skimming and troweling of the disturbed area from which bones were reported. All the bones were encountered either on the surface or from disturbed contexts and were spread over about a 3 X 4 m area. The exposure of an approximately 3 m² area that was most likely the location of the bulldozed tree/ burial(s) revealed a dark stain in the soil, but sectioning revealed it to be shallow (10-15 cm remaining) and no bones were encountered.

At least two individuals are represented by the bones. Bone includes 1 complete cranium, 5-6 other skull fragments, an upper jaw fragment with heavily worn molars, 3 vertebrae, a possible rib fragment, and 1 long bone fragment. The bone was in fair to poor condition and some exfoliating was noted. One incisor is deeply shovel-shaped and the molars are heavily worn. The complete cranium was reported to have come from high within the tree root matrix, possibly indicating that this had been a very shallow burial, perhaps 30-50 cm. This may suggest the entire burial(s) feature was completely removed during the tree removal/bulldozing.

It is likely that there were additional bones in the disturbed soil as well as in the root ball of the bulldozed tree. Since there was no evidence of intact bones, since the bones were exposed at a shallow depth, and since the bulldozing had done its damage, work was not halted in the site area. It was suggested by the archeologists that any further ground-disturbing construction work in the vicinity of the burials should be monitored. The Campbell Ditch Site (18WC100) has no further research potential.
