Phase II The Finizio family, in consultation with ANAREX engineers, proposed the subdivision of approximately 23.43 acres of forests.
Phase III

Project Objectives:
The Anne Arundel County Archaeologist, under the authority of Title 3, Section 109 of the Anne Arundel County Subdivision Regulations, requested an archaeological survey of the tract to determine its historical significance.

Research Potential:

The field crew located and mapped several masonry features and depressions associated with the early 20th -century von Schwerdtner farmstead (18AN1275), most if not all of which will remain unaffected by proposed house construction, registered the von Schwerdtner cemetery (18AN1276), and revised the Maryland inventory form for the Beaver Pond site (18AN133).

Phase II Anne Arundel County, pursuant to of Article 17, Title 6, Subtitles 502 & 503, requested an archaeological site identification survey. Given that the Brewer Point site (18AN133) has already been recorded and a preliminary assessment undertaken in 2005, this investigation is more properly regarded as a Phase II archaeological site evaluation.
Phase III

Project Objectives:
The purpose is to document the extent and nature of the site, its dates of occupation, functions, and condition; observations and analyses informing on a determination of the site's historical significance.

Research Potential:

The southeastern corner of the site on the subject parcel appears to have research value (Criteria C and D) and it was recommend to preserve in place or data recovery based on well-formed and well-informed research questions based on the kinds of data that the Phase II investigation demonstrates are present.
