This report describes archeological work conducted prior to the 1991 expansion of the Carroll Park Golf Course in Baltimore, Maryland. A portion of the project involved Phase II testing at the previously identified Gwin Site (18BC34) located within the proposed project parcel. The project was to consist of the construction of two additional holes. It was conducted in compliance with Article 83B, Section 6-618 of the Annotated Code of Maryland.
