Site files contain the excavation drawings, written records, photographs, and osteological report from the site.

Project Objectives:

-Salvage the burial vaults and contents ahead of pond construction

Research Potential:

The Councill Farm Cemetery site (18CA89) consisted of three 19th century domed brick burial vaults and associated human remains. Two of the vaults were in remarkably good condition, the third having a collapsed arch. Of the human remains, two males and one female were identified. The remains of one of the males (Vault #2) were badly deteriorated, possibly as result of prolonged contact with water. The vaults and human remains were fully excavated and currently two large fish ponds are located in the site area.
