Renovations are planned for the building which is under easement to the Maryland Historical Trust. Archaeological work was undertaken to aid in the restoration and to gather any archaeological information that might be impacted by the renovation. This work is a condition of the easement.

The goal was to record any archaeological information that would be otherwise destroyed during repairs to the foundation. Also, architectural features of the building were sought through the archaeology that would be important in developing the restoration plan.
