The site file contains notes, drawings, and the artifact inventory from the 1978 Phase III excavation of an isolated 17th century burial.

Project Objectives:

-Recover all human remains located within the construction area

Research Potential:

The Keith House Burial (18CE141) represents the remains of what was most likely the late 17th century interment of an adult male. The skeleton, which was nearly complete, was fully excavated. The whereabouts of the skeleton is unknown. The burial's occupant may have been related to one of the two known 17th century households located at Elk Neck.
