<b>Project Objectives:</b>
Phase I -Identify archeological resources present within the project area to provide a basis for recommendations for their avoidance or further study.
Phase II -Clearly establish the boundaries, integrity, and research potential of sites previously identified within the project area, and so provide a basis for recommendations for their avoidance or future study.

## Research Potential:

Because of the limited nature of our understanding of Site 18CH696, little can be said about its remaining research potential. It is recommended that if the site cannot be avoided, researchers return to the locale to conduct additional mitigation work.

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
