Project Objectives:
The goal of this Phase II was to obtain additional information in order to assess the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) eligibility of the site. Specifically, the archeological work aimed to evaluate the vertical and horizontal boundaries of the prehistoric site core, assess integrity and determine the temporal affiliation based on the results of the survey results and artifact analysis.

Research Potential:

The site appears to retain some vertical integrity but appears unlikely to yield cultural features. Therefore, site 18CH847 lacks the potential to yield further significant information on prehistoric settlement patterns and subsistence in Charles County (Criterion D) and as such, is recommended not eligible for the NRHP under Criteria A–D and no further work is recommended.
