## Research Potential:

The Ollie Brinsfield I Site (18DO24) is a late prehistoric archaeological site characterized by shell-tempered pottery and triangular projectile points. The wooded extremities of the site's northern and southern boundaries have apparently escaped cultivation. The relatively undisturbed condition of the site may enable meaningful controlled surface collections and excavations to determine house type and community type settlement patterns, subsistence activities, and other culturally related aspects of prehistoric life on the eastern shore of Maryland during the Late Woodland period, ca. A.D. 900-1500.

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
