Phase III

Project Objectives:

-Determine the horizontal and vertical limits of the archaeological property in question.

-Determine the impact of proposed construction on the archaeological property.

-Determine how the Site contributed to the interpretation of the pattern of prehistoric distribution as well as how it contributed to the interpretation of the distribution of 19th century farmsteads in MD Research Area 12.
