Proposed Alternate 3E traversed the Laser Site and, thus, Phase II testing was required to mitigate the impacts of the road relocation.

<b>Project Objectives:</b> -Obtain information on site boundaries. -Determine depth of deposits. -Determine the basic nature and condition of the site.
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## Research Potential:

The absence of chronological evidence at the Laser Site severely limits the importance of information that could potentially be gained from its further study. Thus, while Site 18PR264 has retained much of its integrity, it is unlikely to provide information important in defining or understanding the area's prehistory.
