| Phase I | <input type="checkbox"/> | Project Justification: This report describes a 1997 Phase II testing program carried out at previously identified Site 18PR379 west of Bowie in Prince George's County. The work was carried out prior to (then) planned development of the "Lakeview" tract into a neighborhood of single-family homes. During the process of development, a Federal wetland permit was requested. This initiated a cultural resources review by the Maryland Historical Trust, which requested Phase II work in partial compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended. |

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| Project Objectives: -Determine the extent of Site 18PR379. -Assess the site's eligibility for listing on the NRHP. |
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Research Potential:

The multi-component nature of Site 18PR379, and the fact that all of the material is mixed within the plowzone with no apparent subsurface features, leads to the interpretation that there is insufficient integrity for this site to provide important scientific information. The site is believed to be not eligible for inclusion on the NRHP on this basis. No additional archeological work was recommended and the site was subsequently destroyed by construction of the new housing development.
