The goal of the Phase II investigation was to evaluate whether or not the site is eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP).

Research Potential:

Site 18PR427 lacks research potential. The absence of stratified deposits and significant features and the presence of large-scale disturbance does not allow for the development of research questions that could address rural lifeways in the 19th through 20th centuries. Therefore, Site 18PR427 should not be considered a significant archeological resource.
