This was a salvage operation. Human bones were uncovered during land clearance for development. Just how much of the site had been destroyed is unclear.

Phase III



Project Objectives:

-Determine if the burial(s) was intact.

-Determine the extent of the burial(s).

-Recover any disturbed remains.

Research Potential:

It is likely that there were additional bones in the disturbed soil as well as in the root ball of the bulldozed tree. Since there was no evidence of intact bones, since the bones were exposed at a shallow depth, and since the bulldozing had done its damage, work was not halted in the site area. It was suggested by the archeologists that any further ground-disturbing construction work in the vicinity of the burials should be monitored. The Campbell Ditch Site (18WC100) has no further research potential.
