Research Potential:

Brief examination of the skeletal remains from the Truitt Site (18WC99) indicates that this was the burial of a middle-aged Caucasian female. It is possible that other burials were once located in the area but may have been removed during sand pit mining. No further study is recommended for the site but future ground moving excavations should be monitored for other historic activity.
