Project Justification:
This report describes work by the MHT's Maritime Archeology Program to relocate and dive on several previously identified targets of interest in the waters off Assateague Island National Seashore. The work was undertaken for the US Department of the Interior, National Park Service (NPS), the State of Maryland, and the Commonwealth of Virginia's Department of Historic Resources (VDHR), pursuant to Amendment No. 2 of Cooperative Agreement CA45060A0054. Four shipwreck sites were documented in detail: two in Virginia and two in Maryland (18DO237 and 18DO238).

Project Objectives:
-Relocate previously identified (potential) maritime sites and assess and evaluate their condition.

Research Potential:

Neither of the sunken vessels identified in Maryland waters (18WO237 and 18WO238) were determined to have sufficient integrity to be considered eligible for the National Register or to have significant research potential. However, despite ineligibility for the NR, resources within a National Park unit should be protected and managed for the enjoyment of the public.
