Research Potential:

The St. Martin site (18WO10) appears to be the remains of a Late Woodland period shell midden and short-term resource procurement camp. The site is believed to have been entirely destroyed during construction of the new bridge, the right-of-way for which passed directly through the center of the site. Thus, it has no remaining research potential aside from analysis of the extant collection which has never been examined in detail.
